



Leopardstown Racecourse Bag Searching Policy

Backpacks and large bags are allowed into the racecourse but will be subject to search on entry.

To avoid lengthy queue's we strongly advised to allow plenty of time to gain entry.

Racegoers should note the following items are prohibited from being brought into the racecourse:

- Alcohol
- Fireworks
- Smoke canisters
- Bottles
- Glasses
- Cans
- Flags
- Banners
- Poles
- Distress signals
- Laser pointers
- Items which might be used as a weapon

There are bag storage facilities inside the racecourse located at the cloakroom on the ground floor of the main grandstand.

If a racegoer does not consent to having their bag searched, Leopardstown Racecourse has the right to refuse admission.

Signage is clearly displayed leading up to and where searches are taking place. The policy and exact procedures will be explained clearly by trained search teams, who are in place on the day before search commences.

Baby buggies and other equipment such as walking aids are permitted inside the racecourse.

You may also be subject to a full body search including a pat down should Leopardstown racecourse feel necessary. Any such item as listed above may be confiscated.

Please note that confiscated items can't be returned once the racegoer is inside the racecourse.

Leopardstown Racecourse reserve the right to search patrons within the racecourse or other parts of the site.
